## Aluminum Cans

- ▶ any aluminum can
- ▶ empty, rinsed, and crushed\*

### EXAMPLES:

- soda cans
- beer cans
- juice cans



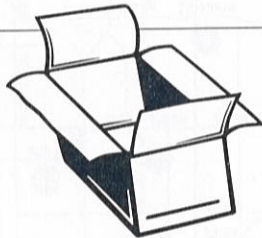
## Newspapers

- ▶ any newspapers (including inserts)
- ▶ dry
- ▶ no string or twine
- ▶ OK to put inside a brown paper bag



## Cardboard

- ▶ any corrugated (3-layer) cardboard box or packaging
- ▶ clean, empty, and dry
- ▶ flatten boxes please
- ▶ no pizza boxes



## Glass

- ▶ any glass jar or bottle
- ▶ empty and rinsed\*
- ▶ labels OK
- ▶ no caps or lids



## Plastic Bottles

- ▶ any plastic bottle
- ▶ no need to look for a #1 or #2
- ▶ **“check for a neck!”**—recycle any plastic container with a neck opening smaller than the base
- ▶ empty, rinsed, and crushed\*
- ▶ labels OK
- ▶ no caps or lids
- ▶ bottles only please; no tubs, cups, trays, bags, or 6-pack rings



### EXAMPLES:

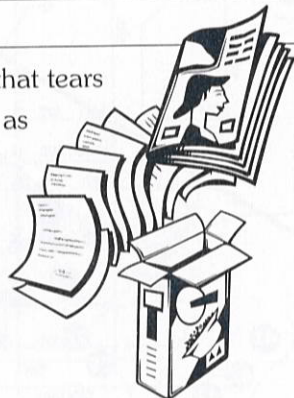
- soda, juice, milk, water, ketchup, mouthwash, salad dressing, cleaners, or detergent bottles

## Mixed Paper

- ▶ any clean, dry paper item that tears
- ▶ no wax-coated paper such as milk cartons

### EXAMPLES:

- white paper
- colored paper
- shredded paper
- magazines/catalogs
- junk mail/envelopes
- brown paper bags
- wrapping paper
- phone books
- folders
- single layer paperboard (cereal, shoe, or cracker boxes; paper towel rolls; soda cartons)

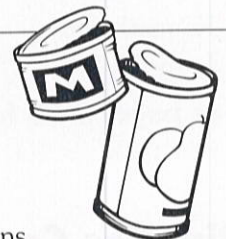


## Steel Cans

- ▶ any steel (tin) can
- ▶ empty and rinsed\*
- ▶ labels and lids OK

### EXAMPLES:

- soup, vegetable, or tuna cans



## ▶ NO PLASTIC BAGS

in curbside or drop-off recycling bins please! Instead, reuse them or recycle them at local grocery stores.

\***“WASH & SQUASH”**— It is not necessary to rinse cans and bottles for collection, but we encourage rinsing for sanitary reasons. You are not required to crush aluminum or plastic containers, but it helps to save space.
